



2012-2013 Student Overnight Travel Requirements

Required Team Meeting Attendance (%):

- MORT University (October-November)
 - 80% - Team members
 - 90% - Student leaders
- Build Season (January-February)
 - 75% total hours – Team Member
 - 85% total hours – Team Leaders
- MORT Volunteer Projects/Events
 - 20 hours all team members
 - Chairman's Team
 - Adopt-a-Spot Cleanup (Fall/Spring, TBD)
 - Attend two community outreach/fundraising events between Oct.-Mar.

Required Team Events:

- MORT – State FIRST Lego League Tournament @ MOHS, 12/8/12
- MORT Kick-Off Event - January 5, 2013
- MORT Roll-Out Event, February 17, 2013
- MAR – Mt. Olive District Event – March 22-24, 2013

Academics:

- Student must adhere to the MORT Academic Policy to remain an active member of the team. (Please reference Policy 30 for further explanation)

General Team Rules as it pertains to qualifying for overnight team travel:

- No video games, cell phones, iPods, other electronic devices during meeting times
- No misuse of machines, tools and equipment
- Follow all proper safety procedures when using power and hand tools
- Student must adhere to our Team Code of Conduct Policy
- Student cannot be dismissed from two team meeting, community outreach and/or volunteer events for discipline reasons. 1st Offense, no volunteer hours earned, 2nd Offense of this nature will result in not being eligible for team travel.

Freshman Travel:

- Freshman/1st Year student members are not eligible for overnight team travel unless recommended for team travel by the team advisors and/or sub-team mentors. With the MORT Beta team starting this year, freshman students/1st Year student members will have an experience unlike any other incoming student. The experience will include full exposure to the Build Season and Competition process which will culminate in attending and competing in two Mid-Atlantic Robotics District Events.
- Freshman/1st Year students who show a strong commitment to the team and our team goals may be given the opportunity to travel with the MORT 11 team after recommendation from student leaders/mentors.
