



Student Volunteer Expectations

Expectations for MORT Student Volunteers

The Mt. Olive Robotics Team needs help from its student members to make our fundraisers and community outreach efforts run smoothly. Volunteering to help the team at these events is one part of the overall equation that we use for students to qualify for overnight team travel. Please read through the below expectations and make sure

- You are representing MORT, your school, your mentors and our community.
- We will try to place you in your preferred assignment, please keep in mind that volunteers will be placed where the need is the greatest when you arrive for your shift.
- At the beginning of each shift, you must sign in with the MORT Parent/Mentor/Student in charge. If given a name badge, which you must wear it during your shift, so that visitors know to ask you for help if needed.
- If you have signed up for a shift, please remember that we are counting on you to be there for your entire shift. If there is a reason that you must leave and can't finish your shift, you need to be sure that the coordinators of the event know as soon as possible.
- Be sure to sign out if you are leaving. It is very important that we know who is still available to help us during our events/programs.
- Please dress professional and/or in MORT clothing when helping out at our events. The image we present to visitors, potential sponsors, etc. is a critical part of what we do.
- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the event/shift so that we can avoid having any gaps in our event coverage.
- If you come to volunteer and are not meeting these expectations, please be aware that you will be asked to leave and no volunteer hours earned for that event.
- If you make a mess, you are responsible for cleaning it up. Too many times, people come at the start of an event and then leave prior to the end to avoid helping with the event cleanup. Many hands

lighten the work, so see your shift through to completion. Show respect for your peers, parents, mentors and team!

- While volunteering at a MORT event, we ask that you do not use the following devices unless directly related to our event. If Mr. Bodmer, Mr. DiCicco , mentor, parent chaperone asks you to put your electronic device away, please respect that request. If there are repeated occurrences of not following this request, Mr. Bodmer, Mr. DiCicco, mentor, or the parent chaperone in charge may ask you to leave the event and no volunteer hours will be earned depending on the circumstances of the situation.

Additionally, many sub-teams such as Programming will need to use these devices (LTs, iPhones, etc.) for the purpose of robot communication, scouting Apps, etc. In these cases, these student members are permitted to use their devices as needed.
